Regulation 18 Preparation of a Local Plan Local Plan 2018-2037 Consultation Draft

Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council is updating the current adopted local plans, specifically the Core Strategy (adopted 2011) and the Site Allocations and Development Management Policies (adopted 2015). This will lead to a new Local Plan to replace the existing adopted plans, and will cover the period 2018 to 2037.

The first stage of the Local Plan review was a consultation on *Issues and Options* in 2019. Since the 2019 consultation, further evidence has been gathered and a draft Local Plan has now been produced. At this stage, the draft Local Plan and draft Policies Maps along with supporting evidence are being made available for a sixweek consultation period from 8th January until 19th February 2021.

In summary, the draft plan presents a **Balanced Growth** strategy, with development proposed in suitable locations to help encourage investment to the area and the new development which Blackburn with Darwen needs. It also seeks to protect the most valuable features of the environment throughout the Borough, and shows the key major infrastructure schemes which are planned to support the new development proposals, such as roads, schools and health facilities.

The consultation documents, including interactive Policies maps can be viewed on the Council's website. You can view all relevant documentation and respond by going to blackburn.gov.uk/localplan.

The Council will consider all responses received during this consultation, and will continue working on its new Local Plan through 2021. In response to consultation feedback, and potential Government planning reforms, the final plan may evolve from its present format. We aim to submit the Local Plan to the Government by the end of 2021, and hope to adopt it during 2022.
